



PROFILE OF ANIRUDH PRASAD, GENERAL MANAGER (SYSTEMS)-(O&M), BCCL

Sri Anirudh Prasad, born on 24th September, 1956, is an Electrical Engineer. He completed B.Sc. (Physics Hons.) in 1975 from Gaya College, Gaya under Magadh University, Bodh Gaya. He secured First Class Second position in Magadh University Physics (Hons.) Examination of Session 1972-74, result declared in 1975. He also completed AMIE in Electrical Engineering from the Institution of Engineers (India), Kolkata in the year 1979. He completed AMIE in only five attempts. He was felicitated by Ranchi Sub-centre of the Institution of Engineers (India), Kolkata for clearing all the five papers of Section – ‘A’ of AMIE Examination in first attempt in which he appeared.

He started his carrier in CIL from August’1980 as JET (E&M) and posted at Saunda Colliery of Barkakana Area, Central Coalfields Ltd. In October’1987 he was inducted in System discipline and posted at Area Computer Centre of Barkakana Area, CCL. He was instrumental in establishing the first Area Computer Centre at Barkakana Area and in implementation of Financial Accounting and Stores Accounting at Area level. Cobol programmes for Payroll of executives, monthly rated, daily rated and piece rated (individual wise) were prepared by him which was implemented successfully. Some other areas of CCL also adopted the same programmes for implementation in their respective Areas. In Financial Accounting new programmes on Cobol platforms were also developed for preparing schedule of Earnest money security deposit and sundry creditors.

On 20.04.2001 he was transferred to Bharat Coking Coal Limited as Dy. Chief Manager (Systems). At BCCL, he was instrumental in preparation of NCWA-7, NCWA-8 and NCWA-9 Arrear bills and executive Arrear bills successfully as per schedule. Total centralized Payroll related activities were managed nicely by him at BCCL.

On promotion as General Manager (System) he joined at BCCL itself. He played a key-role in establishing On-Line-Connectivity between HQ Servers and Area Servers. On-Line-Connectivity between all the Road/Rail weigh bridges and HQ/Area servers has also been established under his guidance. It enables smooth On-Line data transfer within BCCL related to Personnel, Finance, Sales etc. On-Line connectivity within BCCL through MPLS-VPN Network facilitated in reduction of total No. of servers from 17 to 4.
