

ACTIVITIES & PERFORMANCES OF MEDICAL DEPARTMENT-2011-12

MEDICAL MOBILE VAN:

The services of Mobile Medical Van for villagers under command areas of BCCL started in 2009 with the help of 2 Mobile Vans. Now Fourteen Medical Mobile Vans (MMVs) have been pressed into services equipped with doctors, paramedical staff serving different 222 villages situated in and around the mining areas on working days. The villagers are examined by the experienced clinicians and medicines are dispensed free of cost to them. This provision has been made by BCCL exclusively under CSR activities for the benefit of villagers by providing them free medical assistance. The total beneficiaries during 2011-12 were---

WELLNESS CLINICS:

14 Wellness Clinics are functioning in BCCL in all the hospitals/Regional Hospitals besides Central Hospital, Dhanbad for 1 to 2 hrs for counseling the patients for modifying their life style. The patients are made known about the nutritional values of different diets, diet schedules for different diseases, how to lead a happy life, importance of morning walk, how to get rid of stress, value of yoga and different types of exercise etc. Such clinics extend awareness amongst the employees for life style management thus lowering the no. of man days lost at their work site. Obviously such clinics are indirectly helping to improve the production and productivity in a positive way. The total no. of beneficiaries in 2011-12 was ...34536

3. CSR CLINICS:

BCCL has embarked upon by opening of free CSR clinics from 01.04.2009 to provide free patient consultation at Central Hospital (PHC Building, Kalyan Bhawan) and subsequently at all 14 Regional Hospitals which is open to all. These clinics run for one./two hours daily in morning hours and free medical advice is given to people around Colliery areas. The total no. of beneficiaries in 2011-12 was...43349

4. TELE-MEDICINE:

BCCL has installed Telemedicine Centre at Central Hospital, Dhanbad which will paved the way for introduction of new system of treatment based on tele-communication. The treating doctors at CHD may have interaction and discussion on a particular disease or patient with the doctors of super-specialty hospitals in order to provide best possible medical assistance to them. Initially the department has been connected with RTIICS, Kolkata and Mission Hospital, Durgapur; few more corporate super specialty hospital of repute will be connected in the months to come. The unit was inaugurated by Chairman CIL on March 28th.2010 the total number of cases screened under tele-medicine in 2011-12 is 12

5. ARTIFICIAL LIMB CENTRE:

Under CSR activities BCCL has started one clinic at PHC Building Kalyan Bhawan, Jagjiwan Nagar. Aim of the clinic is to examine and enlist handicapped persons followed by to organize camps for them in which free prosthesis will be provided. During 2011-12, 11(eleven) such handicapped persons were enrolled at this centre.

6. EK JAGRAN – JEEVAN SHAILI:

Life Style Management Programmes are being organized by Welfare Department of BCCL assisted by Medical Deptt. In different areas in which de-addiction from tobacco, alcohol, smoking and other ill habits are deliberated. Such programme is arranged amidst thickly populated colonies so that all the members of the family may participate. Lodna and PB area has already organized such programmes. In the year the said programme has been organized in Kusunda and EJ areas.

7. F.W.CAMPS IN BCCL:

During the year 2011-12, 15 Family Welfare Camps were organized in different areas of BCCL in which 828 persons were benefitted.

8. PARTICIPATION IN FW CAMPS AT DVC:

A team of Gynecologists of BCCL undertook 78 cases of tubectomy in DVC Hospital, Maithon on 15th March 2011 and 88 cases in DVC Hospital, Panchet on 7th February 2012 on request of the DVC authorities.

9. HEALTH CAMPS:

Health Camps, which is one of the Parameters under MOUs for Excellence In Company's rating, is done regularly in different areas of BCCL. During 2011-12, 254 Camps were organized against the target of 200 camps in which 20450 persons were benefitted.

10. CELEBRATION OF COAL INDIA FOUNDATION DAY:

On the occasion of CIL Foundation Day, 2011, 60 camps were organized during the month of November, 2011 in which the no. of beneficiaries was 4714. In the year 2010 during this period (Nov.01 to Nov.30, 2010) 32 camps were organized and the no. of beneficiaries was 1970.

10. OPENING OF MEDICAL COLLEGE:

BCCL has marched ahead for opening a medical college at Dhanbad on PPP basis. The proposal has been passed by BCCL FDs and CIL FDs. The proposal will now be deliberated at CIL FDs. Once it is cleared, we shall apply for Essentiality Certificate and No Objection Certificate from Govt. of Jharkhand.

11. NURSING COLLEGE:

Process for the up-gradation of the existing Nursing School at CHD running on Self Finance Scheme has been initiated by sponsoring a Sister Tutor for 2-years M.SC (Nursing) course...One more sister Tutor will be sent for further studies in

the coming session. The matter has already been discussed with Nursing Council of India and necessary requirements for up-gradation are being assessed.

12. RE-ORGANISATION OF DISPENSARIES:

Re-organization of Dispensaries in different areas has already been initiated. In Sijua, Kustore and Lodna areas few dispensaries have already been converted to Mini Health Centers. In Bastacola area, GOCP dispensary has been merged with Tisra Regional Hospital.

13. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES (DGNM / DMLT) :

BCCL is running Diploma in General Nursing & Midwife Course (DGNM) and Diploma in Laboratory Technology (DMLT) courses at Central Hospital Dhanbad on self-finance scheme. Both the courses have been affiliated to the statutory body viz. Nursing Council Of India and All India Council For Technical Education. The total no. of intake per year in DGNM course is 30 whereas in DMLT course is 20.

14. CELEBRATION OF WORLD AIDS DAY:

World AIDS Day was celebrated on December 1st, 2011 in Barora Area. 500 school children marched through the streets of Baghmara raising slogans for awareness of HIV and AIDS. Subhash Auditorium was well arranged to receive the students as well the employees, trade union leaders, members of INMF and dignitaries from BCCL Hqs. Faculties from Jharkhand AIDS Control Society and Central Hospital, Dhanbad delivered their catching lectures on the topic. General Managers of Barora and Block-II areas spoke on the occasion. An impressive Nuked Natak was performed by Bhuli Natya Kala Academy.
