Tender will be received upto 10.30 AM on 06.6.09 in this office, part-I of the tender will be opened on same day at 11 AM in the office of the undersigned. The date of opening of Part-II will be communicated to eligible bidder later on after scrutiny of Part-I.

Part-I should contain the technical terms such as partnership deeds, Power of attorney if any. Earnest money deposit, experienced certificate & tender documents containing general terms & conditions duly accepted by the bidder.

Part-II i.e. price bid should contain B.O.O issued to the tender with rate quoted by them.

The minimum eligibility criteria for the above mentioned work as under.

- i) Only vehicle permissible under the Explosive Act will be deployed on hire. The vehicle should be of commercial use under M.V. Act.
- ii) Vehicle is required to be road worthy and good running conditions.
- iii) Vehicle is required to be covered under appropriate insurance as per M.V. Act. and should have been paid upto-date road tax and valid Road permit fitness, pollution, Explosive carrying Licence issued by the competent authority to carry explosive alongwith valid registration.
- iv) The hire charges quoted per day shall be exclusive of diesel and lubricant. The hire charges should be including cost of maintenance and spares, Driver & Khalasi etc all complete.

- v) The payment of running vehicle shall be based on actual Kilometre run as per Log book maintained for this purpose and accepted by the Controlling officer.
- vi) A recovery at the rate of double the awarded rate per day shall be done in case of bidder fails to provide the vehicle on a particular day or fails to provide alternate deployment in case of breakdown vehicle.
- vii) Management reserves the right to terminate the contract with prior notice of 1(One) month.
