Tender documents can be obtained from the office of the Chief General Manager, Kustore Area, P.O. Jharia (Dhanbad) on my working day during office hours from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Cost of tender documents should be paid only in the forms of cash or Bank Draft drawn from a Nationalized Bank in favour of BIHAR COKING COAL LIMITED payable at Dhanbad.

Completed sealed tender documents (Part-I and Part-II) i.e. technical/Commercial Bid and Price Bid should be submitted at the office of the Chief General Manager, Kustore Area, P.O.-Jharia (Dhanbad) on 01.10.2009 at 3.00 P.M.

1. Eligibility Criteria:

The intending tenderer must have in its name as a prime contractor experience of having successfully completed similar civil works during last 7 (Seven) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid opens. Experience stated in the eligibility criteria should be either of the following:

- a. Three No. of completed work each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.

Two similar completed works each costing not less than amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.

One similar civil contractor should be engaged less than minimum wage is 80% of the estimated cost.

- b) Average annual financial turn over of Civil works during the last three years ending 31<sup>st</sup> March of the previous financial year should be above 30% of the estimated cost.

c) Similar work means 1- Drain work.

In case where tender documents are requested for transmission by post, these would be dispatched by Registered A/D. The department is not responsible for any postal delay in such cases.

Late and delayed tenders, unopened post bids and post tender revisions shall not be accepted at all without any exception.

2. Only part-I will be opened on 01.10.2009. The part-II will be opened only after the department is satisfied that criteria fixed are fulfilled and also the earnest money is deposited i.e. on acceptance of part-I.
3. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
4. Issuance of tender documents does not mean that the parties are considered qualified.
5. The validity of the tender will be 120 days from the date of opening price bid or revised price bid, if any.
6. The management of BCCI receives right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason which is to be done up and distribute the work among the tenderers.
7. The tenderers can go through the standard tender document kept in the office of the undersigned before quoting their rates. The work will be carried out on terms and conditions contained in the NIT and standard tender document.
