Notice Inviting Tenders

Sealed item rate tenders in Part-I(Technical bid) and Part-II (Commercial bid), separately are invited from bonafide, reputed and resourceful diesel driven commercial truck operating firms/ parties for engagement of the following type of vehicle on hire basis exclusive of POL for deployment at Dahibari OCP of C.V.Area, BCCL, as per details given in the tender documents.

10(Ten) tonne capacity - six wheeler diesel driven truck, having half dalla, steel body truck, all the dalls to have hinges for easy opening with bottom plate of the dalla should also have steel make at Dahibari OCP of C.V.Area to ply both at West Bengal and Jharkhand States on hire basis.

Estimated amount : Rs. 4,36,175/- (Rupees four lac thirty six thousand one hundred seventy five) only.

Earnest money : Rs. 4,860/- (Rupees four thousand three hundred sixty) only.

Period of contract : One year

Interested tenderers, desirous to quote for the said purpose, should deposit the prescribed earnest money as noted above, either in the form of cash with the Cashier, C.V.Area, BCCL, Barakar(Burdwan) or through Demand draft, payable to BCCL, C.V.Area No.XII, payable at Barakar, on any nationalised bank.

The earnest money of the un-successful bidders shall be refunded after finalisation of the tender without any interest.

The cost of the tender paper/documents is Rs. 150/- (Rupees one hundred fifty) only, to be paid in cash with the Cashier, C.V.Area, BCCL, Barakar.

Last date of sale of tenders : Upto 4 p.m. of 21.12.2009
On Saturdays, the sale of tender papers will be made upto 12 noon only.

Tender papers can be had from the office of the undersigned on written request with payment of requisite amount towards cost of tender paper, as noted above.

The Part-I(Technical bid) should contain the proof of deposit of earnest money, to be paid either in cash with the Cashier, C.V.Area office or through bank draft, as noted above.

In addition, the Part-I should contain the copies of certificates like upto date fitness of the vehicle, insurance, pollution control certificate, financial capability/Bank guarantee, experience certificate, credentials etc. without which the tender shall be rejected outright.

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Besides above, the Part-I should contain the technical terms such as ownership deeds, power of attorney, if any, and the tender documents containing general terms and conditions duly accepted by the bidder.

The Part-II (Commercial bid) should contain the bill of quantities issued to the tenderers with rate to be quoted by them.

Tenderers are required to submit the Part-I and Part-II envelopes duly sealed and marked Part-I and Part-II, separately superscribing the NIT No. and name of job on the left hand top of the envelopes.

The Part-I of the tenders will be opened on 22.12.2009 at 4 p.m. as the last date of submission of the tenders is

22.12.2009 by 3.30 p.m. The Part-I of the tenders will be opened by the Tender committee, in presence of the attending bidders or their authorised representatives accordingly.

Minimum eligibility of the job will be as follows. :-

Only permitted vehicles, i.e. not older than five years on the date of opening of the tender to be deployed on hire, and, also as per Motor Vehicles Act, such vehicles to be offered for hire, which are registered for commercial use.

The vehicle should be road-worthy, and in good running condition.

The vehicle should be covered under the appropriate insurance, as per M.V. Act and should have upto date road tax, valid road permit, fitness etc. issued by the competent authority.

Diesel will be reimbursed on market price @ 3 km per ltr. on actual run of the vehicle.

The payment of running of the vehicle shall be based on as per indication in the tender paper issued in the form of Part-II (Commercial bid).

A recovery at the rate of double the amount, i.e. awarded rate per day shall be done in case of bidder fails to provide the vehicle.

On a particular day if he fails to provide alternate deployment in case of break-down of the vehicle, the penalty clause as indicated in the general terms & conditions, containing the other details of the tender will be applicable in this respect.

The management reserves the right to terminate the contract with prior notice of one month.

The company is not under any obligation to accept the lowest tender/tenders and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.
