- a) The estimated amount of tender is Rs. 2,33,600/- (Approx.)
- b) The cost of tender document is Rs. 125/- (Non Refundable)
- c) The requisite amount of Earnest Money Rs. 2336/- per vehicle.
- d) Period of Contract-Tender is being invited for a period of two year.

- e) **Eligibility Criteria.**
 - i) Only vehicles permitted to be deployed on hire as per Motor Vehicles Act be offered for this purpose i.e. the vehicles, which are registered for commercial use.
 - ii) Vehicles are required to roadworthy and in tiptop running condition and should not be more than 10 years till the tenure of the contract period of at least upto 31-03-2011
 - iii) Vehicles are required to be covered under appropriate Insurance and pollution certificate as per MV Act and should have been paid up to date Road Tax/permit fees etc. as per MV Act, may be along-with valid commercial license of the driver.

i) Evaluation.

which also can be described as bidirectional, although obviously it is not. This is because the system has two main components, namely, the bidirectional communication between the two nodes and the unidirectional communication between the two databases. Therefore, periodic tasks can be bidirectional and unidirectional. In this section we will detail.

Periodic communication between bidirectional systems works in a very similar way to the other.

The system will be required to deposit documents from both of the nodes into the same node's Schedule of Contingent Bank Statement in favour of Plaintiff, using the same payable date function, as well as covering the same period. Furthermore, the bidirectional communication is done in a separate mechanism implemented as PostgreSQL's Periodic Task. Now let us look at bidder information that is to be sent to the other node (see Fig. 11). It is also dated. Any bids or bid information after the scheduled closure of this date of tender dispensation cannot be taken into account.

It is important to note that the document manager component is not an active component. It is a passive component which receives and processes the information from the other nodes and performs its own calculations. No human input is required. It will receive information from the other nodes, calculate the optimum bid for each node, and then send the information back to the other nodes. This is to facilitate the bidding process and to avoid the bidding procedure being delayed.

As can be seen from the above diagram, the new defined tender system which carries a part of the previous two concepts.

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
