ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ISSUANCE OF TENDER PAPER :

- The intending tenderers must have in its name, experience having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid applications are invited (i.e. eligibility period) and the same should be either of the following:
 - Three similar works completed successfully each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.
 - Or
 - Two similar works completed successfully each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.
 - Or
 - One similar work completed successfully costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
- Average annual financial turn over during the last 3 years ending 31st March of the previous financial year should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- Similar works meanse the tenderer should have experience of underground civil work for sl.no.1 and general civil works for sl.no.2.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- The tenders are to be submitted separately in two sealed covers containing (i) Technical bid & (ii) Commercial bid.
