ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

1. The intending tenderer must have in its name as a prime contractor experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 (seven) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid applications are invited (i.e. eligibility period) should be either of the following :
 - (a) Three similar works completed successfully each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.
Or
Two similar works completed successfully not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.
Or
One similar work completed successfully not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
 - (b) Average annual financial turn over during the last 3 (three) years ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
 - (c) Similar works meanse the tenderers should have experience of drift drivege work in underground for sl.no.1 and general civil work for sl.no.2 only.

M.I.T.

- i) Provision under eligibility criteria No.1(a) shall also include those similar work which have been started earlier than eligibility period of tender but completed during the eligibility period as per M.I.T.
- ii) As per eligibility criteria specified under No.1(a) prequalification shall be done based on experience of successfully completed work and not on experience of work in progress.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. Blasting will be done by the Department.
2. Hauling facility for disposal of debris will be provided by the department.

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3. Compressor and its accessories like rock drill, hose pipe etc. will be supplied by the contractor.
4. Arrangement of dewatering if any will be done by the depts.
5. Supporting items will be supplied by the Deptt.

The tender will be received on 02/03/2009 up to 3.00 p.m. in the office of the undersigned and will be opened on the same day, at 3.30 p.m. in presence of the tenderers or their authorised representatives to be present (only part-I will be opened on 02/03/2009). The Part-II will be opened only after the department is satisfied that the criteria fixed are fulfilled and also the earnest money is deposited i.e. on acceptance of Part-I.
9. In case where tender documents are requested for transmission by post, these would be despatched by registered post/A.M. The department is not responsible for any postal delay in such cases.
10. The earnest money is to be deposited as per detail given in the tender.
11. Conditional tender will not be entertained.
12. Issuance of tender documents does not mean that the parties are considered qualified.
13. The experience as given in the eligibility criteria should be in the same and style in which tender is filled. The experience in the name of some other firm/company will not be considered for this purpose.
14. The validity of the tender will be 120 days from the date of opening of price bid or revised price bid if any.
15. The management reserves the right to reject any or all the tender received without assigning any reasons whatsoever and to split up and distribute the work amongst the tenderers.
16. The tenderers have to submit Permanent Account Number (PAN) of a income tax and TIN.
