ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A) The intending tenderers must have in the name, experience and having successfully completed similar works during last seven years ending, last day of month previous to the one in which bid application are invited i.e. eligibility period should be other of the following :-

a) Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.

Or

b) Two similar completed work each costing not less than amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost

Or

c) One similar completed work costing not less than an amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

N.B. "Similar work means the nature of work as described in the name of work should match with the work successfully completed"

B) TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1) The tenderers must have average annual financial turn over during the last three years ending 31st March of previous financial year i.e. in 06-07,07-08 & 08-09 should be at least 30% of the estimated cost


2) Tender will be received in two envelopes. The first envelope (to be marked as first envelope) should contain experience certificate in his own name/firm and earnest money may be deposited with the associate finance in terms of cash or demand draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of Bharat Coking Coal Ltd. payable at Dhanbad. The intending tenderer must submit Permanent income tax account number (PAN)

3) In the 2nd envelope (to be marked as 2nd envelope). The tender paper with rate should be submitted. Tender documents can be had from the office of the undersigned on written request on any working day from 22/5/09 to 23/5/09 on payment of requisite cost as indicated above to be deposited in cash with associate finance in Sijua Area.

4) The tender will be received up to 3.00 P.M. on 26/5/09 in the office of Area Manager (Plg.), Sijua Area and tenders will be opened in the office chamber of AGM, Sijua Area by tender committee in presence of tenderers or their authorized representative at 3.30 P.M. on the same day i.e. 26/5/09.

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- 5) Rate to be quoted in % above/below of the estimated cost both in figure and words in the prescribed forms, to be issued by the management.
- 6) The contractors will have arrange their own equipments/machines such as, Compressor, drill machine, including drill rod & drill bit, auxiliary fan etc. required for the work.
- 7) The statutory taxes will be recovered as per existing norms.
- 8) Payment of minimum wages to workmen in force will strictly be followed.
- 9) Tenderers have to be fully acquainted with the site conditions, drawing etc. before submitting their tender.
- 10) In case of any injury/accident it will be responsibility of the contractor to pay all legal dues their workers.
- 11) Validity of the tenders shall be 120 days from the date of opening offer of price bid.
- 12) Conditional tender will not be accepted.
