NOTICE INVITING TENDERS

Sealed tender in two parts (I & II) are invited from experienced and eligible Contractors for the following work :

Availability of Tender documents from dt. 20.07.2009 to 22.07.2009.

Tender documents will be issued on all working days during working hours except on Sundays & Holidays. In the event of the specified date for submission/opening of bids being declared a holiday, bids will be receipt/opened on the appointed time on the next working day.

Date & time of receipt of tender : 24.07.2009 upto 1.00 P.M.

Date & time of opening of tender : 24.07.2009 at 3.00 P.M.

Eligibility Criteria :

1. a) : The intending tenderer must have in its name as prime Contractor experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 (seven) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid applications are invited (i.e. eligibility period) should be either of the following -
- i) Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 4% of the estimated cost
  - OR
  - ii) Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 5% of the estimated cost
  - OR
  - iii) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 30% of the estimated cost.

The terms similar nature means experience in civil work including structural steel work.

- b) Average annual financial turnover of civil works during the last 3 (three) years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year should be atleast 30% of the estimated cost.

The intending tenderer must submit documentary evidence in support of (1) (a) & (b) above in the form of certified copy of work order, completion certificate, payment certificate/vouchers etc. indicating the period of work for which the payment has been made, duly signed by him/ them.

- Note:- (i) provision under eligibility criteria 1.(a) shall also include those similar work which have been started earlier than eligibility period of tender but completed during the eligibility period as per MIT.
- (ii) As per eligibility criteria specified under Sl.No.1(a) pre-qualification shall be done based on experience of successfully completed works and not experience of work in progress.




2. The tender documents can be had from the Office of the Area Civil Engineer, C.V.Area, Barakar, from 20.07.2009 to 22.07.2009 on deposition of requisite cost of tender paper in form of cash or Bank Draft of nationalized Bank in favour of Bharat Coking Coal Limited payable at Barakar.

3. Complete sealed tender documents (Part I & II) should be submitted at the same time. Part I shall consist of terms and conditions of the tender, additional terms and conditions if any, technical bid and credentials and earnest money. Part-II shall consist of tender documents of sold to the tenderers duly filled rate, amounts etc i.e. price bid.

The tender will be received on 24.07.2009 upto 1.00 P.M. in the Office of the undersigned and will be opened at 3.30 P.M. on the same day in presence of the intending tenderer or their authorised representative in the office of the undersigned. Only Part-I will be opened on 24.07.2009. The part-II will be opened only after the depts. is satisfied the criteria fixed are fulfilled and also the earnest money is deposited i.e. on acceptance of Part-I.

4. The earnest money is to be deposited as per detail given in the tender documents.
5. Sales Tax clearance certificate copy attested by Gazette Officer of the Govt. (Central or State) and TIN No.
6. The tenderers have to submit permanent Account Number of Income Tax (PAN No.). Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
7. Issuance of tender documents does not mean that parties are considered qualified.
8. The experience as given in the eligibility criteria should be in the name and the style in which tender is filled. The experience in the name of some other for Company will not be considered for this purpose.
9. The validity of the tender will be 120 days from the date of opening of price bid or revised price bid if any.
10. The Management of BCCL reserves right to reject any or all tender or split the work among two or more tenderers without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
11. In case of contract for a period of more than six months, payment of wages to the contract workers through Bank Cheque.
12. Service Tax is applicable as per rule.

14. The contents of the tender documents available in our offices, shall be deemed as authentic.
