ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA.

1. The intending tenderers must have in its name, experience of having successfully completed civil works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the on which bid application are invited (i.e. eligibility period) would be either of the following:
 - A. Three similar completed civil work each costing not less than the amount equal to the 40% of the estimated cost.
OR
Two similar completed civil work costing not less than the amount equal to the 50% of the estimated cost.
OR
One similar completed civil work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
 - B. Average annual financial turnover of civil works during the three years ending 31st March the previous financial year should be atleast 30% of the estimated cost.
2. Similar nature means Agency has completed the building works successfully.
 - i) Provision under eligibility criteria shall also include those civil works which have been started earlier than eligibility period or under but completed successfully during the eligibility period or tender but completed successfully during the eligibility period as per NIT.
 - ii) As per eligibility criteria specification under pre qualification shall be done based on experience of successfully completed work and not on experience of work in progress.
 - iii) Bidders shall not be under declaration of in eligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by the Company.
3. 5% Security Money on the awarded value of the work will be deposited before execution of work / Agreement.
4. Tenders are to be submitted in two sealed covers containing i) Technical Commercial Bid ii) Price Bid. The Technical Commercial Bid should contain the proof of eligibility criteria fixed above and also the Earnest Money. Part-I shall be opened on 9.7.2009 at 12.30 P.M.. The Part-II containing Price Bid will be opened by the Committee only after the department is satisfied that the eligibility criteria are fulfilled and also the Earnest Money is deposited to the acceptance of part-I.

5. The Management or BCCL reserves the right to reject any or all the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever then to split up and distribute the works among the tenderers.
6. No Tender will be issued or submitted by Postal Means.
7. The Earnest Money should be deposited in ruim or Demand Drafts from Nationalized Bank prepared after the date of NIT in favour of BCCL account payable at Dhanbad.
8. The Tender documents can be had from the office of the ACE(BTA), Bhulli on 6.7.2009 to 7.7.2009 up to 3 P.M. in deposition of requisite cost of Tender Paper.
9. The Tender will be received on 9.7.2009 up to 12.00 Noon in the office of the ACE(BTA) and will be opened on the same day i.e. on 9.7.2009 at 12.30 P.M. in presence of intending tenderers or their authorized representatives.
10. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
11. No materials will be supplied by the department for the work and will be responsibility of the contractors for procurement of the same at his own cost.
12. Issuance of Tender Documents does not mean that the parties are qualified after opening of Part-I offers, the same will be scrutinized by the Tender Committee.
13. Experience given in the eligibility criteria should be in the name and style in which tender is filled up. The experience in the name of the other firm/ company will not be counted for the purpose.
14. The validity of the tender will be 120 days from the opening of offers or revised bid if any.
15. All taxes will be borne by the Agency.
16. There will be no Arbitration clause.
17. The tenderers have to submit PAN NO. and SALES TAX REGISTRATION NO./TIN NO.
18. The Contractor has to submit the form of Affidavit which is enclosed in the tender paper. Without Affidavit the tender will not be accepted.
19. The declaration of the tenderer that the tender has not been banned delisted Black Listed by the Govt. or Quasi Govt. PSU it should be submitted alongwith the Tender Documents.
20. All running A/C Bill shall be paid by
