- b) Part-II i.e. Price Bid containing the Tender Documents issued to the tenderers where in rate shou be furnished (in figures & words)will be open by the tender committee, only on acceptance of the Part-I bid.
- Zeroder documents will be issued on <u>06.08.2009</u> on written request & on depositing the requisit cost during working hre, from the Office of Area Civil Engineer, P. B. Area.

PRE-QUALIFICATION / ELIGILIBITY CRITERIA (DOCUMENTS / CREDENTIAL TO BE ENCLOSED:

- Average annual financial turn over of Civil works during the last years ending 31st March of the previous financial year should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- Similar works means that the tenderer should have experience of construction / maintenance repairing work of Civil works.
- iii) Experience of having successfully completed similar work during last 7(Seven) years ending last date of the month, previous to the one in which bid application are invited should be either of the following
- Three similar complete works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost
- Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.
- One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost in addition to above, the criteria regarding satisfactory performance works, personal, establishment plant equipment etc may be incorporated according to the requirement of the project work.
- d) For underground / works in the mines tenders should have adequate experience of working in the mines within the norms and rules applicable for u/g works.
- 3. Conditional tender or tender without the proof of the earnest money deposit are liable to be rejected.

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- 4. If any information and documents submitted by the tenderer is found to be false / incorrect at ar time, department may be cancel concern tender and action as deemed fit may be taken against the tenderers including termination for feature or dues including earnest money delisting of the firm are all partners of the firms etc.
