Terms & conditions

- 1. The approximate requirement of the Articles for <u>one year</u> has been noted against items of the annexure-A. The rate should be quoted per unit, materials will have to supplied immediately against the supply order inclusive of all incidental charge.
- 2. Sales tax/VAT if applicable will be paid extra which is to be mentioned clearly.
- 3. Delivery of articles will be made to central hospital Dhanbad <u>free of charge</u>.
- 4. Rate quoted shall be firm & FOR Destination . Finalised rates will be valid for a period of one year from the date of approval and subsequent communication to successful bidder. At the first instance bidders are required to offer rates of quoted items for supply in Feb, March &April 2011 only. There after separate price in sealed envelop will have to be submitted on 24th April 2011 for supply in May ,June & July 2011 . Similarly Separate price of quoted items in sealed envelop will have to be submitted on 24th July 2011 for supply in Aug,Sept, & Oct. 2011 and on 24th Oct 2011 for supply in Nov,Dec 2011 & Jan 2012.
- 5. Earnest Money Earnest Money of Rs.32,400.00 shall be deposited inform of Demand Draft in favour of BCCL@2% of the value as detailed in tender notice. And 8% of bill value will be deducted from the vendors bill as Security deposit which will be refunded after successful completion of contract. . State/Central Govt.Organisation /PSU & Valid DGS&D/NSIC registered (for tendered items) , firm shall be considered for exemption for submission of EMD/ Security money ,if they can produce documentary evidence.
- 6. Past experience for supply of Tendered items/Diary items to important institution must be given along with the Techno commercial Bid experience of supplying these items in Govt .Undertaking/State Govt./other Govt.institutions will be preferred. However decision in this regard will be solely at the discretion of Management.
- 7. The bidders must give a declaration that they have not been banned or de listed by any government or quasi-government agencies or PSU's. If a bidder has been banned by any government or quasi government agencies or PSU's. This fact must be clearly stated and it may not necessarily be a cause for disqualifying them. If this declaration is not given, the bid will be rejected as non response.
- 8. The Tender must submitted in two part in separate sealed cover part-1 be super scribed as commercial Bid and contains Techno commercial Bid details such as experience, Last Income Tax clearance certificate and sales Tax .Registration No. if applicable. Part-II will be super scribed as Price Bid and contains rate in the Tender form. Only Part-1 tender will be opened on due date & time mentioned in the tender form Part –II of the tender will be opened after wards only if the part-1 is found acceptable.
- 9. Payment Term- Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of receipt of materials and submission of bill whichever is later
- 10. <u>Submission of tender</u> The tender should reach the undersigned duly complete sealed and signed and dropped in tender box provided will be room of Sr.Manager(Stores) Central Hospital Dhanbad after which the tender will be opened in presence of the tenders or their authorized agent on above mentioned date & time. Unsigned, incomplete, conditional tender or tender received late through post or otherwise will be not considered
- 11. Rate must be quoted both in figure & words. Only type written Tender shall be accepted
- 12. <u>Penalty Clause</u> For non supply of ordered items penalty of Rs 100.00 per day shall be levied and the firm's performance shall be kept recorded for future dealings with them. Penalty clause in perishable items where daily supply of items which are taken, LD clause as per purchase manual may be imposed for supplies beyond the stipulated delivery period.
