2. <u>Earnest Money/Bid Security</u> :

₹50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakh) Guarantee (from any Scheduled Bank payable at its branches at Dhanbad / Kolkata) with validity 28 (Twenty eight) days beyond the validity of the Bid in the format given in the Bid Document. Certified Cheques and Demand Drafts will also be acceptable as Earnest Money/Bid Security drawn in favour of Bharat Coking Coal Limited on any scheduled Bank payable at its branch at Dhanbad.

3. Eligibility Criteria (to qualify for the award of the contract) :

a) The bidder must have in its name experience of having successfully executed works of similar nature (such as Transportation / Removal of Coal/ Overburden/ Shale/ Extraneous materials/ Sand/ etc.) valuing 65% of the annualized value of the work or the estimated value of work whichever is less, put to tender in any year during last 07(seven) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid application are invited.

For substantiating past experience, the bidder should submit the work orders, certificate of actual works already executed and TDS certificates.

- b) The bidder must produce evidence of adequacy of a minimum working capital (either 20% of the annualized value of the work or the estimated value of the work whichever is less) for this contract. In case of obtaining credit, the certificate from scheduled bank should be produced.
- c) The bidder is required to give an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit in the prescribed format to deploy matching equipments/tippers/pay loaders etc either owned or hired. (Format placed in Annexure F of Tender Document)
- d) **Sub Contractor's experience** and resources will not be taken into account in determining the bidders' compliance with qualifying criteria.

Four sealed envelopes as mentioned above shall consist of : (1) Envelope for cost of tender document & undertaking (in case tender document is downloaded from website), (2) Envelope for Earnest Money Deposit, (3) Envelope for Techno-Commercial bid (Part-I) and (4) Envelope for Price Bid (Part-II). Name of the work along with tender notice Ref. No. and date should be superscribed on the left hand side of all the sealed covers.

On the date of opening of tender, the envelope containing cost of tender document & undertaking (in case tender document is downloaded from website) and the envelope containing Earnest Money will be opened first and if these are found to be in order as per requirement of NIT, then only the envelope for Techno-Commercial bid (Part-I) will be opened otherwise the tender will be rejected without opening Techno-Commercial bid (Part-I).

Envelope for Price Bid (Part-II) will be opened only in respect of such tenderers as found valid after scrutiny of Techno-Commercial Bid (Part-I).

The bidder shall give an undertaking in the form of an affidavit enclosed as Annexure-G of tender document to the effect that they shall not utilise contract labour but shall utilise their permanent workforce throughout the period of contract. The bidder shall also comply with the statutory requirements of various acts including CL(R&A) Act.

13. All the payment will be made by ELECTRONIC MODE through bank. The intending bidders must furnish the details in the proforma in triplicate as per Annexure-H of tender document as an item of requirement of the tender for e-payment and enclose the same with their Part-I offer of the tender.

14. a) The contractors will have to keep the provision of AC operated cabin in the surface miners deployed by them for which a self undertaking is to be submitted by them along with the bid document.

b) For dust suppression measures and lighting for Surface Miner and other accessory equipment, clause no.39.00 of 'Special Terms and Conditions' of tender document may be referred to.

15. The Company (BCCL) shall provide the required land for execution as available in a phased manner and/or restrict the magnitude of the work depending upon the availability of land for the purpose for which the contractor will have no claim on BCCL and no compensation on this ground will be paid to the contractor. The balance land as mentioned in the Price Bid (Part-II) of the tender document are required to be purchased/acquired by the contractor. Engagement of contractor for this purpose may be considered as facilitator for land acquisition. Land acquired by the contractor as facilitator shall have to be transferred legally in the name of BCCL for which Area have to take all necessary steps. However, the land proposed to be worked should be in physical possession of the Area authority free from any encumbrances.
