CORRIGENDUM

NIT Ref. No. : BCCL/CED/TC/NIT-7/2010-11/929-60 dated 22/24.05.2010.

In respect of above referred NIT, for the work of "Scheme for Multi-purpose utilization of surplus mine water from Barora, Block-II & Govindpur Areas at BCCL". The eligibility criteria for the subject work will be as follows instead of as displayed in the website.

"1) Eligibility criteria :-

a) The intending tenderer must have in its name as a prime contractor experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 (seven) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid applications are invited (i.e. eligibility period) should be either of the following :-

Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost. OR Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost. OR One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

Similar work means : Water Supply and Pipe Line Works

- b) Average annual financial turnover of civil works during the last 3 (three) years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- c) Bidders who meet the minimum qualifications criteria will be qualified only if their available bid capacity is more than the updated estimated value. The available bid capacity will be calculated as under:

Assessed Available Bid capacity= (A x N x 2 – B), where,

A= Maximum value of Civil Engineering Works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to present level @ 5% per calendar year) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N= Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which bids are invited.

B= Value at present price level, of existing commitments and on going works to be completed during the next 15 (fifteen) months (period of completion of works for which bids are invited).

The intending tenderer must submit documentary evidence in support of (1) (a), (b) & (c) above in the form of certified copy of work order, completion certificate, payment certificates/ vouchers etc. indicating the period of work for which the payment has been made, duly signed by him/them.

Note:- (i) Provision under eligibility criteria 1. (a) shall also include those similar work "while considering the value of completed works, the full value of completed works be considered whether or not the date of commencement is within the said seven years period."

(ii) <u>As per eligibility criteria specified under Sl.No.1(a)</u>. <u>Pre-qualification shall be done based on</u> <u>experience</u> of successfully completed works and *not* on experience of work in progress."

Similarly Clause No. 2 and 3 of the subject NIT shall be read as follows instead of as displayed in the website.

"2) The tender documents can be had from the office of the General Manager (Civil), Civil Engineering Department, HQ., Koyla Nagar, Dhanbad during the period mentioned above on deposition of requisite cost of tender paper in form of cash or bank draft of Nationalized bank/ scheduled commercial bank approved by Reserve Bank of India in favour of Bharat Coking Coal Ltd., payable at Dhanbad.

- 3) Completed sealed tender documents (part I & II) should be submitted at the same time.
 - **Part-I** shall consist of terms and conditions of the tender, additional terms and conditions if any, technical bid and credentials.
 - **Part-II** shall consist of tender documents as sold to the tenderers duly filled in for rates, amounts etc. i.e. price bid.

The Earnest money deposit is to be submitted in a separate Envelope superscribing "<u>Earnest</u> <u>Money Deposit</u>"

The bid shall be submitted in three separate envelopes.

Envelope-I should contain E.M.D. and the cost of tender document if down loaded from the website. **Envelope-II** should contain Part-I of Tender Document **Envelope-III** should contain Part-II i.e. Price Bid. **Thereafter, all the three envelopes should be submitted in one sealed envelope**.

The tender will be received on 24.06.2010 up to 3.00 P.M. at C.I.S.F. Post, near Koyla Bhawan gate, Koyla Nagar, BCCL, Dhanbad and will be opened at 4.00 P.M. on the same day in presence of the intending tenderer or their authorized representative in the Office of D.T. (P&P), Level - II, Koyla Bhawan, BCCL, Dhanbad. <u>Only part-I will be opened on this date.</u>

The Part-I will be opened only after receipt of EMD and in case of downloaded tender, the cost of tender document too.

The part-II will be opened only after:

The department is satisfied that the criteria fixed are fulfilled i.e. on acceptance of part-I."

All other terms & conditions in the original NIT referred above remains unchanged.
