- ii) Vehicle are required to be covered under appropriate insurance as per MV Act and should have been paid up to date Road Tax/Permit Fees etc as per MV Act, as the case may be, along with valid registration .The explosive Vans must have valid licence as per requirement of Explosive Act.1884 & Explosive Rule 1983.
- iii) Bidder must indicate the number of Vehicles he is offering for hiring while submitting Part-1of Techno-Commercial Bid.
- iv) Normally the vehicle s should be owned by renderer. In case the vehicle is not owned by the renderer, the details with Reg.
