Sealed tenders on %age (percentage) above/ below basis on prescribed bill of quantity are hereby invited for the following job from the resourceful and experienced contractors and the same will be received up to 3.00 pm on 05/10/2010 and will be opened on the same day at 3.30 pm in presence of the tenderers /their authorized representatives. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ISSUANCE OF TENDER PAPER

1. The intending tenderers must have in its name, experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 yrs. ending last day of month previous to the one in which bid applications are invited (i.e. eligibility period) and the same should be either of the following:

i) Three similar works completed successfully each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.

Or

Two similar works completed successfully each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.

Or

One similar work completed successfully costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

2. Average annual financial turn over during the last 3yrs. ending 31st March of the previous financial year should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.

3. Similar works means the tenderers should have experience of underground Civil works.

NOTE :

- Provision under eligibility criteria No. 1(i) shall also include those similar work which have been started earlier than eligibility period of tender but completed during the eligibility period as per NIT.
- As per eligibility criteria specified under No. 1 (i) prequalification shall be done based on experience of successfully Completed works and not on experience of work in progress.

TERMS & CONDITION :

1. The tenders are to be submitted separately in two sealed covers containing (i) Technical bid & (ii) Commercial bid.

- The first sealed cover marked Part – I i.e. Technical bid should contain terms & conditions, details of previous Experience, Earnest Money deposit receipt and other credentials.
- The sealed cover marked Part – II i.e. commercial bid should contain offer of the tender i.e. tender documents of company. The percentage should be mentioned in figures and in words.

2. The sealed cover marked Part – I will be opened & scrutinised first and if the terms & conditions are fulfilled then Part –II will be opened. The date of opening of Part – II of the qualifying tenderers will be intimated at a later date.

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3. The estimate, plan & specification of the work can be seen in the office of the undersigned during working hours. Any other info. can also be obtained from the undersigned.
4. The tenderer has to deposit E.M. as stated above A.F.M. EJ Area in cash or in shape of Demand Draft of Nationalised Bank in favour of BCCL payable at Dhanbad. The money receipt of EM /DD should be attached with the tender. The Tender without E.M. will be outrightly rejected.
5. The tender documents can be obtained from the office of the undersigned from 01/10/2010 to 04/10/2010 during working hours on deposition of requisite cost of tender paper.
6. Tender document can also be down loaded from website <http://bccl.cmpdi.co.in> & <http://tender.nic.in>.
7. The tender documents down loaded from website, cost of tender documents (application fee) should be submitted in a separate envelop marked Part – III alongwith undertaking that the tender documents as available on the website is accepted.
8. The contractor have to submit Permanent Account Number (PAN) of income tax and TIN.
9. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received or split up and distribute the work between more than one contractor and no reason for the rejection of all or any of the tender will be given.
10. The rate should be quoted inclusive all taxes and royalty. The validity period of the tender will be 120 days.
11. Materials required for the work are to be arranged / procured by the contractor.
12. In case rates are not acceptable and reasonable to the Management the offer may be rejected.
13. The experience in the eligibility criteria should be in the name & style in which the tender is filled. The experience of partner if any or some other firm / company, will not be counted for the purpose.
14. Any Bank draft prepared after the scheduled closure of Sale of Tender documents may be liable for rejection. Tender not accompanied with cost of tender documents may be liable for rejection.
15. The successful tenderer will have to deposit Performance Security Money as per norms before issue of work order.
16. The tenderer must submit an affidavit with their offer as per Civil Engg. Manual & declaration that they have not been banned or delisted by any Govt. or Quasi Govt. agencies or PSUs.
17. Conditional tender will not be entertained.
18. The work will not be subject to any arbitration.
19. The contractor should abide by the Labour Act of Govt. of India.
