1. The contractor is required to submit his/ their discount offer in sealed cover giving reference to this notice number and date as well clearly super scribing the cover with the name of the work. Separate cover is to be used for each work.

2. The Bidder is encouraged to visit and examine the Site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for submitting the bid. The cost of visiting the site shall be at the bidders own expense and it shall be deemed that the bidder has visited the site/area.

3. The Bidders shall offer for the whole works as described in bill of quantity submitted by the Bidder, however, the Employer reserves the right to allot part of the work at their discretion and no claims, whatsoever, shall be entertained in this regard.

4. The Bidder shall fill-in rates and prices for all items of the Works described in the Bill of Quantities. Corrections, if any, shall be made by crossing out, initialing, dating and rewriting.

11. Matter relating to any dispute or difference arising out of this tender and subsequent contract awarded based on the bid shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Dhanbad court only.

12.
