

## **Pre EOI meeting of interested Agencies for Skill Development CSR Project of BCCL for FY 2023-24:**

1. Category of external implementing agency (as per classification of implementing agencies issued by MCA, GOI, vide General Circular No. 14/2021 Dt. 25/08/2021, point 5.2):
  - A company established under section 8 of the Act, or a registered public trust or a registered society, registered under section 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961
  - Entity established by the Central Government or State Government – a company established under section 8 of the Act, or a registered trust or a registered society
  - Statutory bodies – any entity established under an Act of Parliament or a State legislature
  - Other bodies – a company established under section 8 of the Act, or a registered public trust or a registered society, registered under section 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961
2. Skill development training for candidates selected from operational areas of Dhanbad in FY 2023-24.
3. The external agency has to scout the potential candidates, interview/counsel them, select the candidates across trades, admit them for the skill development project and maintain Management Information System of the same.
4. Course curriculum- recognized by GoI.
5. Placement/entrepreneurial norms- as per GoI guidelines.
6. Trades to be proposed based on skill gap analysis and which can be scaled up in future.
7. Indicative list of trades:
  - I. Trades such as electrician, fitter, welders, mechanics etc.
  - II. Paramedical and health related
  - III. Beautician and other hospitality sector
  - IV. Training in industrial sewing machine

- V. Heavy motor vehicle driving training
- VI. Training at Central institutes like CIPET etc.
- VII. New age trades such as solar repairing, led repairing, drone training etc.

The above trades are non-exhaustive.

- 8. The Criteria for selection of implementing agency are mentioned under Annexure 'A'.
- 9. Skilling projects shall be to support coal mining or its allied/dependent industry, to provide persons affected by coal mining with an alternate source of livelihood.
- 10. Meeting tentatively in 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> week of August, 2023 in front of CSR Task Force Committee of HQs. The interested Agency shall have to participate along with its PPT, estimated expenditure as well as work plan; exact date shall be updated on the social media handles of BCCL.
- 11. Physical venue of meeting shall be BCCL Hqs, Koyla Bhawan, Dhanbad, Jharkhand or through virtual mode as desired by implementing agency

- 13. Based on the presentation by the Agencies, EOI may be separately called for by BCCL in which the Agencies can participate and the lowest bidder qualifying across all the norms shall be selected.
