BCCL is a Mini ratna company and a subsidiary of Coal India Limited under Govt. of India. BCCL is running a Central Hospital in Jagjivan Nagar, Dhanbad. It is also running a Nursing Course i.e. DGNM Course, approved by INC, Delhi & JNRC, Ranchi.

The School of Nursing, Central Hospital Dhanbad, came into existence 70 years back in the year 1951 for imparting teaching and patient care training to the nursing students. The School celebrated its Golden Jubilee in the Year - 2001.

This school is duly approved by Indian Nursing Council.

The main objectives of this school are to impart Diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery and thereby to create awareness and skill in the nursing process in the provision of health care and nursing of patients.

(a) Minimum education qualification is Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) / equivalent examination in Science/Arts/Commerce Stream passed from a recognized institution with english subject having minimum 40% marks and on aggregate minimum 45% marks for general category and 40% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non creamy layer) category.

(b) Students should be Medically fit (Physically and Mentally)

(c) Candidate must be a Citizen of India

(d) Only unmarried female candidates are eligible for the course.

**Age Criteria:**

Minimum age for admission is 17 years and upper age limit is 23 years (as on 30th September 2021)

**Application Process:**

The filled-up application forms at the time of submission must be accompanied with following Documents:

Self Attested photocopies of certificates and passport size color photograph (two).

- (a) Class 10 Board- Original Passing Certificate/Admit card (for date of birth proof)
- (b) Class 10+2 or Equivalent Mark Sheet & original /provisional Passing Certificate.
- (c) Valid caste Certificate for those who belong to SC/ST: caste certificate issued by not less than Sub-Divisional Officer/District Magistrate.
- (d) Valid caste Certificate for those who belong to OBC (NCL). The caste certificate for financial year 2021-22, issued by not less than Sub Divisional Officer/District Magistrate or equivalent person authorized by the concerned state & shall specify that the candidate belongs to non-creamy layer.
- (e) Candidates of Economic Weaker Section (10% EWS) of General category have to produce valid EWS certificate with the application form. Original certificate to be submitted at the time of verification of certificates for admission. The certificate shall be issued by not less than Sub Divisional Officer/District Magistrate or equivalent person authorized by the concerned state. Certificate should be issued after 31.03.2021.
- (f) The reservation quota for SC/ST/OBC (Non creamy layer) will be strictly as per existing rules of Jharkhand Govt.
- (g) All candidates have to submit duly filled application form along with required documents via speed post / Registered post only.

**Submission of application form :**

Duly filled up application form along with the application and the requisite documents as mentioned above (a to e) should be submitted only by Registered/Speed Post up to 31<sup>st</sup> August,2021 to The Principal, School of Nursing, Central Hospital, Dhanbad Jagjivan Nagar Dist-Dhanbad, (Jharkhand), Pin-826003. The applications received after 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021 shall not be entertained. The School mgt. will not take any responsibility for any delay in receipt and loss in postal transit for any application or communication.

**Application Fee:**

Prospectus and Application form may be available at counter of school of Nursing Central Hospital Dhanbad during working hours from 09.00 AM to 02 August 2021 to 05 PM, of 21 August 2021 on production of Bank Draft for ₹ 150/- (Rupees One Hundred fifty only) on counter OR it may be obtained by post by sending a request letter along with a crossed Demand Draft for ₹ 195/- (Rupees One Hundred ninety five only) in favour of BHARAT COKING COAL LIMITED or BCCL payable at DHANBAD please quote your name on the back of the demand draft.

**Selection Procedure:**

Selection will be made strictly on the basis of best of 4 subjects i.e. 3 other subjects with ( science/ arts/ commerce) compulsory 40% in English of all streams (science/ arts/ commerce).

The aggregate marks of those four subjects should be at least 45% in case of General category and 40% in case of SC/ ST/ OBC (non creamy layer).

**Method of Selection:**

Candidates selection for admission to the courses will done on the basis of merit list prepared according to the marks obtained (English & other Subjects) in 10+2 / intermediate or equivalent exams as mentioned above under the selection procedure.

In the event of tie of marks, science candidate with biology will be preferred over candidate with mathematics/ arts/ commerce.

In the event of tie of marks between two biology (PCB) candidates the one with higher marks in biology will be given preference.

If there is tie in biology /arts/commerce, marks of candidates, older in age will be given preference.
